DIRECTIONS

From Tampa International Airport/Westshore Area:

- Exit the Tampa International Airport and follow the signs to 589 North/Veteran's Expressway (\$2.25 in Tolls) (Exit 39)
- Continue north until you reach Lutz Lake Fern Road (Exit 16)
- Turn left on West Lutz Lake Fern Road for approximately ½ mile
- The entrance to TPC Tampa Bay will be on your right

From Downtown Tampa/Ashley St., Harbour Island (Veteran's Expressway):

- Take Ashley St. to I-275 South. Continue south on I-275 S to 589 North/Veteran's Expressway (\$2.25 Tolls) (Exit 39)
- Continue north until you reach Lutz Lake Fern Road (Exit 16)
- Turn left on West Lutz Lake Fern Road for approximately ½ mile
- The entrance to TPC Tampa Bay will be on your right

THE GOLF COURSE

The 18-hole championship golf course, designed by course architect Bobby Weed and PGA player consultant Chi Chi Rodriguez, offers spectacular views as players meander the wide fairways surrounded by natural lakes and wetlands. Opened in 1991, TPC Tampa Bay's 6,900 yard course is a challenge for scratch players, but also gives way to an enjoyable round for players of all skill levels. The course gives the players the opportunity to play well within their game, with a variety of teeing areas that allow the course to be played from 5,036 yards from the forward tees to 6,898 from the championship tees.

The course is routed around natural wetlands, cypress heads and numerous ponds and lagoons, which are home to an abundance of wildlife. Deer, foxes, otters, armadillos, alligators, egrets, storks, cranes, blue heron and eagles all inhabit the golf course. This natural setting and wildlife variety is the reason why TPC Tampa Bay is an Audubon International Recognized Facility. Additionally, TPC Tampa Bay has been home to 21 Consecutive Champions Tour Events.

SCRAMBLE

This format is probably the most enjoyable type of tournament because only the best shots are played and the pace of the game is very fast. All players drive, the best ball is selected and all players take their next shots from that point. The process is repeated until the ball is “holed out.” The team records one score. Gross scores can be used and handicaps are not required. The scramble format promotes easier and faster scoring.

BEST BALL

This format may be played as 2, 3, or 4 person teams. Golfers play their own ball on each hole, and the lowest score is then recorded to be the team score. This format may be played with or without a golf handicap. This is usually a fun format with a medium pace of play. Results can be calculated quickly.

SKINS

An individual play format: a “skin” is a point given to the player with the lowest score on an individual hole.

SHAMBLE

This format combines the scramble and best ball formats and can be played in 2, 3, or 4 person teams. All players drive, the best ball is selected and all players take their next shots from that point. Each player then plays their own ball for the rest of the hole and the lowest score is recorded to be the team score.

LONGEST DRIVE

Prize awarded for the longest drive from the tee-box (in the fairway); normally played on the course’s longest par 5.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN

Prize awarded for the shot that comes to rest closest to the pin – played on a par 3.

LONGEST PUTT

Prize awarded to the person who makes the longest putt on a specific green. This is typically played on a low handicap par 4.



Each tournament or outing is different from the next. Whether you are looking to hold a company outing for 20 players, or are hosting a charity fundraiser for 144, we are happy to tailor a pricing package to fit within your budget. RESERVATION & CANCELLATION POLICY

All events must be guaranteed by a signed contract and deposit. We request that you return the signed contract and submit the deposit by the specified date outlined in the contract. Failure to do so may result in removal of the outing from the starting sheet. A guaranteed number of players are required two weeks prior to your event date. Your group will be charged for the guaranteed number provided, or the actual number of players, whichever is greater.

A deposit of 25% of your estimated master bill is due within 2 weeks of executing your contract. The balance of your master bill will be due on the play date. We require a credit card number to be held on file to guarantee any outstanding balances the day of the event.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Once play has begun, you will be charged for the entire event. If less than 5 holes are completed due to inclement weather, each participant will be eligible to receive an 18-hole pass. If less than 14 holes are completed, each participant will be eligible for a 9-hole pass. Once more than 14 holes are finished, the round will be considered complete. TPC Tampa Bay management, at its sole discretion, will determine if the event must be shortened or canceled due to unsafe or unplayable conditions.

DRESS POLICY

Our dress code is designed to maintain the highest standards of golf etiquette. Bathing attire, cutoffs, jeans, jean shorts, short shorts, halter tops and tank tops will not be permitted while using any golf facilities. Gentlemen are asked to always wear collared golf shirts or golf “mocks.”



FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Choose the date of the event
- Estimate the number of players expected
- Guarantee the reservation with a major credit card or check

6-8 WEEKS PRIOR

Assess your merchandise needs for:

- Tee gifts for participants
- Tournament prizes
- Staff or volunteer needs
- Order banners and/or hole sponsorship signs
- Order hole-in-one insurance, if needed
- Update Club with estimated number of players

4 WEEKS PRIOR

- Choose your menu and finalize the Food & Beverage contract

2 WEEKS PRIOR

Your Tournament Coordinator will request details on the following:

- Final player count
- Format of your competition
- Course contests
- Hole-in-one insurance and prize information
- Special needs for sponsors, volunteers, etc.
- Number of tables needed for registration
- Accurate title and spelling of the event name
- Gift certificate needs

- Other set up information, such as putting contests, placement of tee prizes, placement of sponsor signs, etc.
- Reconfirm the start time and format and player count

3 DAYS PRIOR

1 DAY PRIOR

- Send an updated player list if there are any changes
- Deliver Signs and Banners

DAY OF THE EVENT

- Deliver any signs, banners, prizes or hole-in-one cars that need to be pre-staged the evening prior for an A.M. event and at least 2 hours prior for a P.M. event
- Allow one half hour prior to your scheduled start for registration for every 40 players (*for example, 2 hours for 140 players, 1 hour for 80 players*)
- Communicate any last minute player changes
- Final payment for the use of the course is due

AFTER THE EVENT

- Remember to pick up any leftover prizes, banners or signs
